# PLANNING TEMPLATE: EXTRA-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

This is a worked example:



#### STEP 1: IDENTIFY THE OPPORTUNITIES

Ask: What extra and different could can students learn and experience that will give them improved cultural capital alongside deeper subject expertise?

### Example:

Building trips into an English curriculum journey

### STEP 2: SET THE SUCCESS CRITERIA

Ask: What will success look like at the end? How will we know we've been successful? What data will we use to assess this (both qualitative and quantitative)?

#### Example:

- Evidence that extra-curricular activities have linked with subject enjoyment
- Improved academic performance in English
- Evidence that students feel more confident in attending theatres and watching films

### STEP 3: CHOOSE AND JUSTIFY THE EXTRA-CURRICULAR EXPERIENCES

Ask: What will we do? Where will we go?

#### Example:

- Theatres
- Cinema
- Festivals such as The National Fisteddfod of Wales

### STEP 4: MONITORING AND EVALUATING

Ask: What data will be used throughout (monitoring) and at the end of (evaluation) the curriculum journey to ascertain whether success has been achieved?

### Example:

GCSE outcomes in English

Qualitative data derived from pupil voice surveys

#### STEP 5: LOGISTICS AND COSTINGS

Ask: What are the staffing implications for this? What resources will be required? What financial costs will be incurred?

#### Example:

- Organising and accompanying students on out of school experiences
- Preparing pre and post-experiences resources to ensure students are prepared and debriefed

- Cost of tickets
- Cost of transport
- Cost of books that link to the experience
